


# INSTALLING SHOPIFY AS AN ALTERNATE PAYMENT OPTION

This article will guide you in setting up your Shopify store to use Shopify as an alternative payment method and configure settings on the payment page.

## SHOPIFY STORE CONFIGURATION

1. Login to your **administration account** for your Shopify store.  
*NOTE: You must use your stores owner account, because Shopify only allows owner accounts to change payment settings.*

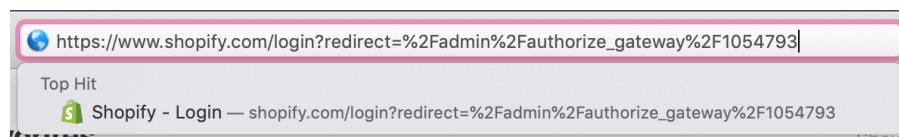

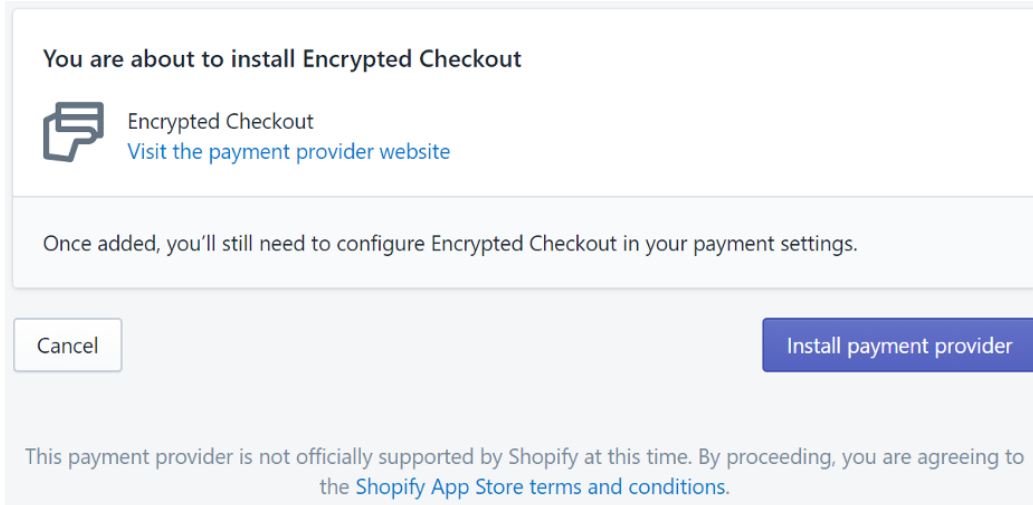

2. Once logged in to your Shopify store as the Store Owner, navigate to the URL bar in your browser and copy and paste the following URL in to that URL bar:

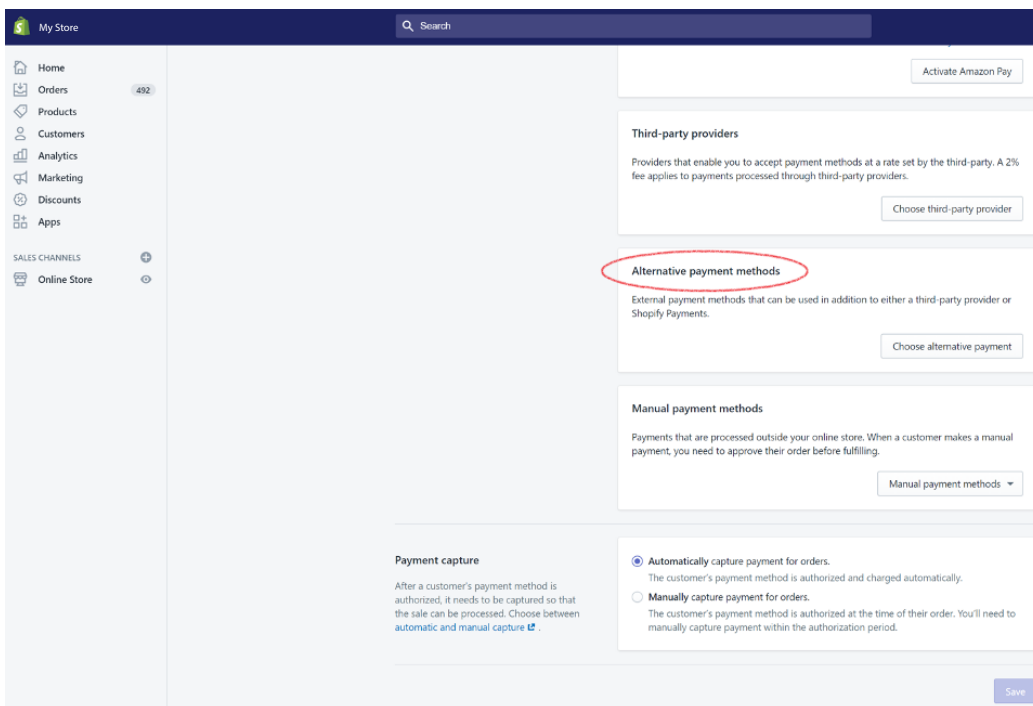

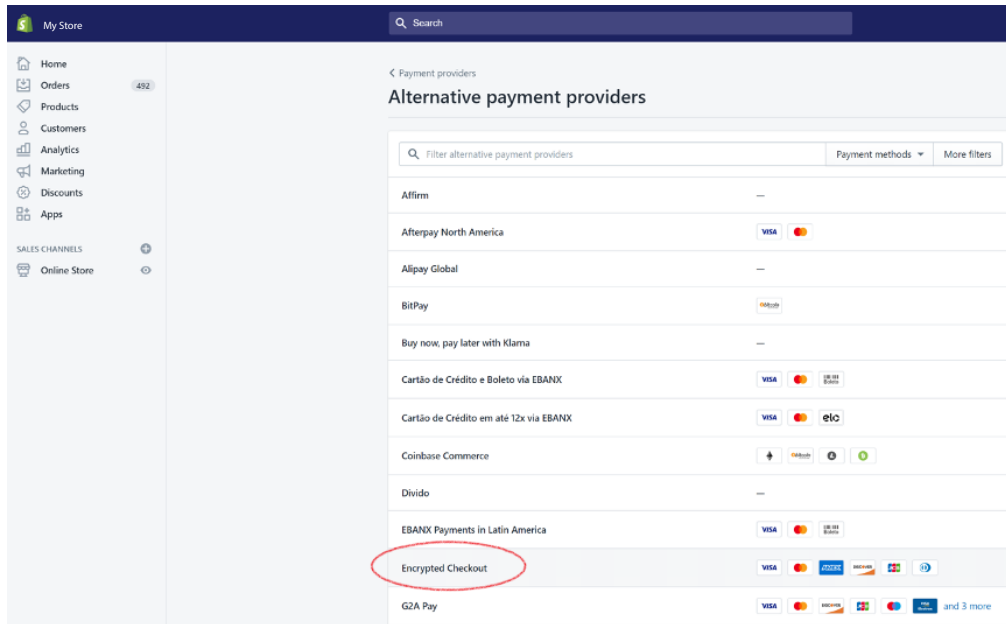
3. After you enter the URL and hit enter you will be directed to the following site. Click on the button **“Install payment provider”**.



4. This will install a new payment option in your Settings | Payment providers, which Shopify will redirect you to, scroll down until you find **Alternative payment methods** and click the **Choose alternative payment button**.



5. Search for **Encrypted Checkout** in your Alternative payment providers and click on that when found.



6. Configure **Payment Gateway** with **API Login ID** and **Transaction Key**, and select accepted payment types.
